To qualify applicants must be:

- Enrolled in an accredited university or college in the State of Wisconsin.
- Earned a 2.75 grade point or better and have achieved junior status.
- Declared a Family and Consumer Sciences Education major.
- A student member of WFCE

Application Requirements:

- A completed copy of the application form.
- Signature of undergraduate FCE program director/department chairperson.
- The application should be sent to committee chairperson by the May 15, 20**

Students may apply for and receive a WFCE pre-certification scholarship in both their junior and senior year of college. Applications will be collected and evaluated by the student scholarship committee. Recipients are notified by the committee chairperson and invited to the annual conference . Scholarships will be announced at the WFCE Annual Conference.
