A. Newsletter:

The name of the WFCE newsletter will be WFCE VISION.

1. The duties of the VISION Editor shall include:
 - a. Compile and edit all issues of VISION
 - b. Responsibility for distribution all bulk mailings for for WFCE organization
 - c. Participate/attend all Executive Board and Council meetings

2. Each WFCE VISION may contain:
 - a. the President's Letter
 - b. the New Member Welcome
 - c. the DPI Update - pertinent information for elementary/secondary Family and Consumer Sciences Education teachers from DPI
 - d. Professional to Professional section - written by university people about issues, courses, etc. relevant to elementary/secondary Family and Consumer Sciences Education teachers
 - e. CESA Connections - what has happened or will happen to involve Family and Consumer Sciences education teachers in networking within CESA districts written by your CESA representatives.
 - f. Upcoming Calendar of Events- dates, places for events of interest to elementary/secondary family and consumer education teachers - conferences, workshops, or meetings
 - g. Resource Finds - news articles, or whatever, to read or review. Any member making a resource find should include:
 1. two or three sentence review/comment on how used or why it's pertinent
 2. the article title, what publication, date, pages, etc.
 3. Contact information the name and address of person submitting resource find
 - h. Committee requests for help from the membership, and information regarding work of the committee.
 - i. Information regarding Members In Action
 - J. Update on Annual Conference
